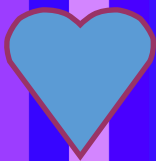

### Deadline:

Completed applications and any supporting materials must be received by the above date, at the address listed in Step 3. Soroptimists, soroptimist employees and the immediate families of both are ineligible, as are previous Veronica Thee Service Award winners.

### Step 1: Determine if you are eligible

Eligible applicants are young women who:

- \* are currently high school seniors
- \* have demonstrated initiative both identifying a problem and trying to solve it

### Step 2: Complete the application by going to the General information page after reading the instructions.

\* Click on a line (a couple times) to start typing. A cursor will appear and you can begin typing to personalize the application. Move to where you want to type.

(Note: You will not be able to change the type size. Please limit your answers to the space allotted. There are 2 pages for you to type your essay.)

\* Once all parts of the form are personalized, select "Save As" (save as PDF) from the "File" menu and change the file name (for example, "Mary Smith Application") Click "Save". (good place is save on your desktop.) Send your application to [drkarenchao@gmail.com](mailto:drkarenchao@gmail.com) If you are unable to complete application on your computer, print it out and either type into it or print legibly and mail to the address below.
